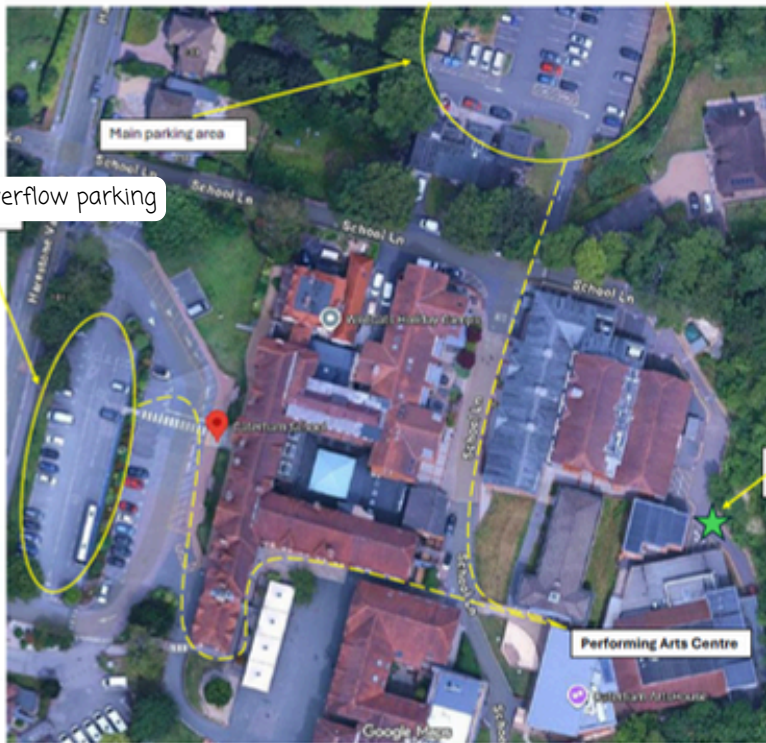

Arrival & Parking



Arrival and Parking

When you first arrive at the school, please enter through the main entrance on the left-hand side of Harestone Valley Road. Once on site, take the first left to access the Main Car Park.

If the Main Car Park is full, please return to the entrance and continue straight ahead to the Overflow Car Park, which is located at the front of the school site.

The site is clearly signposted, making both parking areas easy to locate.

Accessible Parking

A limited number of accessible parking spaces are available on site.

If these spaces are unavailable, we recommend using the drop-off point at the rear of the Theatre, which provides step-free access along the pathway.

Please note that this area is for drop-off and pick-up only and parking is not permitted.

Does it cost anything?

To take part in the shows doesn't cost the gymnasts anything. It is part of our programme this term and learning gymnastics routines is a really important part of gymnasts development. The only cost to you is the tickets to watch and their costume should this need to be sourced.

Everyone provides their own costumes and the team carefully choose costumes which work well with the routine and music. We always do our best to keep costumes to around £10.00 or below, often choosing options that you may already have.

No Watching Period

During our Summer Show preparation we do not allow parents watching within the gym. There are a number of reasons for this. Firstly, those children practising towards their performance feel a lot more confident to try new dances, lifts and choreography without grown up's watching. They also really love the aspect of surprise and being able to show you their routine for a grand reveal on the stage. For the past 10 years, we have operated the same procedure with fantastic results.

Those gymnasts who are not participating in the shows, are able to come in for a full training session, but we keep the rule strict with no watching.

The children (especially younger children) who may want their parents to watch do not understand why some can and some can't and it causes confusion.

Therefore the rule is across the board. Parents are welcome to stay on site in the corridors or local cafe area's in the venues with access to these facilities. With our youngest gymnasts we ask that they are taken to the toilet before the class begins. If they do need the toilet in the middle of the class, the coaches will come out and find the parent and ask them to bring them back into the gym once they have finished.

We ask for your support and thank you for your patience during the 5 week lead up to the shows. We promise it is ALWAYS worth the wait!

Can't Make the Shows?

That is okay! We understand not everyone can make it. If you are not taking part in the shows, you must notify us on the reception desk at your earliest convenience - before show practise starts on the 11th April. Your child will still be able to attend their regular day and receive a full lesson on equipment, however when there is usually only 1-2 gymnasts per class who are not taking part, they are able to come in to train together. Your time may be slightly different to your usual class.

You will receive the same length class that you normally train for.

When do they start practising?

April 11th is our first non-watching training session for shows and our first opt-out training times. This will continue for 5 weeks up until Friday 15th May, with Shows on the 16th & 17th May



Opt Out Training Times

If you are not participating in the shows it is important you let us know right away. Annabelle will contact you with confirmation of your closest warm up time based on the charts below to your usual lesson time. Tickets

There are 350 seats in the Theatre.

Tickets are not limited per person

Seats are allocated on General Admission. Small children who do not wish to have their own seat, and would rather sit on a lap do not need to pay to watch.

There is disabled access and space at the front of the theatre for wheelchairs.

Please show your tickets upon entry into the theatre, so they can be scanned.

You are able to choose your seats when you book your tickets when booking general admission

Siblings & Multiple Shows

If you have gymnasts from your family in multiple shows, and therefore you will be watching more than 1 show, there is a multi-show discount for tickets.

We have tried to keep the weekend as affordable as possible for the larger families, who can often find events like this too expensive.

For every ticket purchased in a show, you will receive subsequent tickets for the second and third show at half price the Standard rate.

For example:

Sibling 1: performing in Show 2

- you have purchased 3 x Standard tickets at £12.50 (early bird rate)

Sibling 2: performing in Show 6

- You will be entitled to purchase 3 x multi-show tickets at £7.50 each

You can only purchase one multi-show ticket for every full price paid (eg you can not pay full price for 1 x ticket in Show 2, and request 5 x multi-show tickets for Show 6)

Standard Ticket £15.00 (Early Bird £12.50 until 14/04/26)

FG Gymnast watching £5.00

Multi-Show Tickets: Standard £7.50 / FG Gymnast £5.00

Multi-Show Ticket T&C's

- Can only be booked via reception at the gym.

There is no online discount code available to book on the website yourselves.

- You must present to the reception desk your current booking with number of full price tickets booked.

- If you wish to book the multi-show discounted tickets, you can not choose your seats, these will be allocated to you and you will be emailed the booking reference and tickets.

- The back 2 rows of the theatre have been blocked off for multi-show ticket sales.

- If you do not wish to sit in the back 2 rows, you do not need to accept the multi-show discount and can book any seat you like at full price at the time.
